Dear Property Representative:

A re-inspection was made on your building on October 13, 2016, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on or after November 18, 2016.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Garage SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-The garage is structurally damaged and unsound. There are very large and deep cracks on the walls all around the garage. Contact a structural engineer at DSI for more information.
- 2. MSBC -Section 105.1 Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit. Work being done requires a permit.-A permit is required for the work performed on the garage and for the installation of the new siding.
