Hi,

I have a message from Greg Vanwert that I will return but I won't get into any specifics of the site plan requirements since I don't want to confuse things here. I did check the permits and it appears that the building permit was finaled now as of 11/10. The permit was approved as an S-2 parking garage only from the look of it so I will be advising the owner that he needs to discontinue the occasional vehicle repair he was doing inside of the building unless he obtains approval for that as an S-1 repair garage.

My understanding is that we can close out the Vacant Building folder as soon as I have approved the fire certificate of occupancy. I see no need for a Vacant Building Code Compliance inspection to be scheduled with trades since he has just received sign-offs on his original construction permits. I have confirmed with Angie that we are not able to issue a fire CofO until the zoning issues are handled in addition to the building permit final. He would need to take care of the site plan approval and then modify the way he is using the exterior so that it truly matches up with what is shown on the site plan.

This appeal is due back to hearings soon from his appeal of the vacant building registration. Our position is that he should take his extension request before Marcia in the appeal if he is proposing to continue occupying the building prior to completing the site plan work.
