11. Describe the steps that will be taken to minimize the noise levels

Red Bull and Visit Saint Paul are very cognizant of the neighbors near the event location including those in Irvine Park and Irvine Park Towers as well as residents off of Chestnut Street behind Cossetta's. We would like to work closely with DSI to get some accurate measurements of the sound these events produce. We will utilize a decibel reader and do some readings throughout the day and evening. Production crews will have decibel readers to ensure they are staying below the 95 decibel at 50ft reading. As the organization with the name on the sound variance for the full event, Visit Saint Paul will be sure all entities are aware of sound level restrictions.

12. Briefly state reason for seeking variance:

We are seeking this variance in conjunction with the Red Bull Crashed Ice Championships event taking place in front of the Cathedral.

West 7th will be the Crashed Ice Village for fans of the event to come to before and after the event. We are seeking the variance to play music from five locations (three outdoors, two in a tent from 2-11pm and then two in the tents until 1am.) This is a national event that Saint Paul is the only US location to host 6 times. Red Bull is flying in nationally renowned DJs to perform at this Crashed Ice Village and it is imperative that this sound variance be considered for the experience of our visitors. The extended time is due to the fact that the event on the hill runs until 9pm and by 9:30 most of the people have made it down to the Village for the after party. An extra half hour in the street and hour in the tents allows for it to feel like an actual after party event.
