## **Description:**

This project will finance the acquisition and construction of a public safety training facility for use by the City's Police Department located at 600 Lafayette Road. In addition, a new Communication Services and Maintenance garage will be built to house the Police Department's radio facility at 1675 Energy Park Drive. Finally, this project includes the buildout and equipping of an administrative office space for the Police Department in the downtown area.

## Justification:

The public safety annex located at 100 E 10th Street is an aging and deficient building which is currently being utilized by the Police Department for several critical needs. The indoor shooting range, defensive tactics training area, training classroom, Special Investigative Task Force Office, storage for the Maintenance Unit, and the Communication Services and Maintenance garage are all housed in the building. There are numerous mechanical and cosmetic concerns with the current facility that are not cost effective to fix and the space does not meet the demands of the City's police force. After evaluating current and future needs, the City has decided to move forward with new facilities for these functions and is evaluating plans for the old public safety annex site.
