**Noise Source:** UpTempo Races has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for music and announcements at Kelly's Landing, Harriet Island for the Fast & the Furry event. The variance is requested at a sound level limit of 90-100 decibels (dBA) at no specified distance for the hours of 8:00 a.m.to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 20, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) the variance shall be for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for the Fast & the Furry event on Saturday, May 20, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
