BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 17-758

Pertaining to a Joint Powers Agreement between the Board and public agencies of jurisdiction to share the cost of improvements to the Sucker Lake channel between Sucker Lake and Highway 96 in Vadnais Heights.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This JPA provides for construction of shoreline and recreation infrastructure improvements along the west shoreline of Sucker Lake channel between Sucker Lake and Highway 96.

Vadnais-Sucker Lake Regional Park is owned by the Board and managed by Ramsey County, pursuant to a Joint Powers Agreement between the parties dated November 22, 1994.

The County will be the project administrator and financial contributions from affected agencies are as follows:

\$30,000	Board of Water Commissioners
\$60,500	Ramsey Conservation District
\$65,000	Vadnais Lake Area Watershed Management Organization
\$180,500	Ramsey County
\$336,000	•

The Board's contribution is towards shoreline improvements, which directly affect water quality. Besides the \$30,000 contribution, the Board's only other responsibility is to control the water level of the channel during construction, subject to the Board's water supply requirements.
