- 1. Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including: garbage, rubbish, loose and scattered litter. discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items. building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from yard areas. REMOVE ALL IMPROPERLY STORED ITEMS THROUGHOUT REAR YARD. Comply before April 11, 2017
- 2. Exterior WOOD STOARAGE MUST BE OFF THE GROUND. NO CLOSER THAN 10 FEET TO A HABITABLE STRUCTURE. RELOCATE WOOD PILE AWAY FROM STRUCTURE, AND MUST BE RAISED OFF THE GROUND. Comply before April 11, 2017

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before April 11, 2017, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipments, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expensed for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN A CRIMINAL CITATION
