This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. <u>Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.</u>

Description of Variance:

Locations: Kellogg Mall Park, between Wabasha and Robert at the intersection of Cedar and Kellogg Boulevard **Noise Source:** B Horst Productions, Brian Horst, Event Director, has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 80 dBA at no specified distance, in order to provide music outdoors at the Kellogg Mall Park at Kellogg Boulevard and Cedar Street. The Event is to occur every Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 13 through Tuesday, October 31, 2017, except Tuesday, July 4, 2017 through Friday, July 7, 2017, from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 2:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 2:30 p.m. until 3:00 p.m., every Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 13 through Tuesday, October 31, 2017, except Tuesday, July 4, 2017 through Friday, July 7, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., every Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 13 through Tuesday, October 31, 2017, except Tuesday, July 4, 2017 through Friday, 2017. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:00 p.m. on the dates of the event.
