# Intervention & Prevention

- **Junior Academy**
  - 6 Academies serving 180 youth ages **8-14**.
- **PAL**
  - 44 Events serving 5,000-6,000 youth ages **5-17**.
  - Last week a 5yo caught fish with the police
- **Bikes/cops/kids Western district**
  - 24 EVENTS SERVING 750-1000 youth ages **7-12**.



# Intervention & Prevention

- **East African Outreach**
  - 52 events serving 2,000 to 2,500 youth ages **6-21**.
- **Community Ambassadors**
  - 411 hours of service time working with 2635 youth.
- **Safe Summer Nights**
  - 18 events serving 6,000-8,000 youth all ages.
  - 900 meals served per event



## What are we doing well? Connecting with youth through pro-healthy activities & education

- **PAL**
- **SRO** – 5 arrest for by SROs 2016-17 School Year
- **Explorers** – 90% diverse
- **Junior Police Academy** – targeted neighborhoods
- **East African Outreach (Highwood Hills Grant)**
- **Safe Summer Nights** – targeted outreach
- **Community Ambassadors** – High Risk Youth Outreach
- **Bike/Cops/Kid** – Western District



# What are the challenges/opportunities?

- Department Collaboration / Communication
- PIO's working together
- Better Training around Trauma/ Race Equity Inclusion
- Promoting/supporting each others programs



# What is the disconnect in youth programs?

- Lack of long term relationships with youth and families.



# What issues are outside of your control?

- Poverty
- Transportation ( SPPD Vans)
- Communication non-citizen youth



# Demographics

**SPPD Programs - more then 70% of the participants in our programs are youth of color. In several of the programs it is 100% youth of color.**

## **Examples:**

- SRO 71% youth of color
- Explorers 90% youth of color
- East African Outreach- 100% youth of color

- PAL- City \$63,000 In-Kind 90,000
- SRO- City \$150,000
- Explorers- City \$67,000
- Junior Academy- City 9,000
- East African Outreach-City \$10,000 Grant 100,000
- Community Ambassador- City \$775,000
- Bikes/Cops/Kids- City \$5,000
