Fire Supervisor AJ Neis stated he spoke to the field inspector and talked to Fran from Liberty Plaza yesterday. He advised Fran that even though the damaged light fixture belongs to the tenants, it is a valid correction order; however, you meet the requirements to be EXEMPT from having CO alarms. He has instructed field inspector to abate the orders on these items. He also advised him to abate the bathroom wall order for 415 Marshall, Unit K (Item 19) as it's a personal mirror and not part of the wall that poses hazard and is not part of the building construction.
