## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

### **Sound Level Variance Rondo Rush Bike Race**

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

#### **Description of Variance:**

**Location:** Intersection of Mackubin Street and Selby Avenue

**Noise Source:** Nomad Marketing has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level of 105 dBA at no specified distance, in order to present amplified music and announcements at the intersection of Mackubin Street and Selby Avenue for the Rondo Rush Bike Race on Saturday, July 22, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:50 a.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following: 1) Variance will be for amplified music and announcements for the hours from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:50 a.m., on Saturday, July 22, 2017 for the Rondo Rush Bike Race. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 85 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 4:00 p.m. on July 22, 2017.
