To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to request a date extension in regards to completion of my driveway at 1649 Chamber Street. Attached are copies of:

- 1) my contract with Aurora Asphalt & Concrete, Inc. for driveway installation;
- 2) A copy of the check used to place deposit (from my husband, Al Flory) and;
- 3) Emails between me and Aurora Asphalt documenting my attempt to schedule driveway installation.

As background, my driveway installation was originally scheduled for the fall of 2016. However, I discovered plans for an extensive sewer project in the neighborhood (Idaho-Atlantic paving project of which more information can be found at: <a href="https://www.stpaul.gov/departments/public-works/road-construction/2017-idaho-atlantic-sps">https://www.stpaul.gov/departments/public-works/road-construction/2017-idaho-atlantic-sps</a>)


At that time, I postponed the scheduled driveway installation because of rumors that my sewer pipe ran under the driveway. I desired to update the sewer pipe from the house to road hook-up – and did not wish to have a new concrete driveway torn up. By the time I understood the extent and timing of the project, Aurora Asphalt informed me the temperatures had dropped too low to install the driveway. (Apparently concrete does not set properly if temperatures become too cold.)


I hope to have the driveway completed this summer and/or fall, depending upon when Aurora Asphalt can get construction scheduled. Please be aware I've never used this house as a rental property. I've lived in this house for over sixteen years and have worked to maintain the property in good condition, including extensive interior renovations. I'm confused as to why we need to go through so much paperwork to avoid being fined, and why we need a Certificate of Occupancy. Your assistance is much appreciated.

1. EXTERIOR - DRIVEWAY - SPLC 34.08 (7) - All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9898. -Maintain the driveway; weeds and grass are growing all over it.







If you're not scheduled too far out, it looks like you can start the driveway BEFORE they big equipment arrives on Chamber Street.

Instead of completing the driveway to the street, please complete it to the edge of the sidewalk that would be closest to the house. (Base this on my neighbor's sidewalk, since I don't have a sidewalk - yet.) The city will finish the driveway aprons.


