<b>Brussels sprouts</b>	90-100	The hardiest - down to 20°	<b>Mustard greens</b>	30-40	Survives light frost
<b>Cabbage</b>	50-90	The hardiest - down to 20°	<b>Peas</b>	70-80 (longer than if planted in spring)	Survives high 20s
<b>Cauliflower</b>	60-80	Survives light frost	<b>Radishes</b>	30-60	Dig until soil freezes
<b>Cilantro</b>	60-70	Survives light frost	<b>Spinach</b>	35-45	Survives light frost; may overwinter
<b>Collard greens</b>	40-65	The hardiest - down to 20°	<b>Swiss chard</b>	40-60	Survives light frost
<b>Garlic</b>	Harvest the following July	Winters over in ground	<b>Turnips</b>	50-60	Survives light frost
