On Wednesday, July 19<sup>th</sup> during the City Council meeting's discussion on Coordinated Trash Collection, Council Member Dan Bostrom shared with residents and members of the Council the Maplewood Trash collection rates and compared them to the St. Paul proposed contract rates. The difference in the rates caused concerns among residents and City Council members because no context was provided to illustrate differences in rates and services exist between the St. Paul proposal and Maplewood rates.
