Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Building Exterior Wall SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-The exterior wall has been damaged as a result of a vehicle collision. Repair the damaged exterior wall in an approved manner. A building permit is required for this work.
- 2. Building Roof SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-Repair/replace the leaking roof. Maintain the roof weather-tight and free from defects. A building permit is required for this work.
