Your building was inspected on August 10, 2017 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on September 8, 2017 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Basement - MSFC 605.5 - Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.

- 2. Exterior MSFC 307.1 All fires on the ground must be a minimum of 25 feet from structures or contained in a grill or outdoor fireplace. Wind speeds must be under 10 mph, constantly attended, a means of extinguishment must be provided. Only natural firewood can be burned (no construction materials, brush or waste materials), and fire shall be extinguished if the smoke is deemed a nuisance. A citation will be issued for non-compliance. -Remove fire pit from property next to house.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (6) Remove the accumulation of exterior storage that creates a nuisance or harbors rodents. -Remove storage of pallets from property next to house.
- 4. Main floor Bedroom MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.
- 5. Third floor TV MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
