**Noise Source:** Twin Cities in Motion has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide amplified sound for announcements, speakers and/or music, from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 30, 2017 and from 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 1, 2017 at 75 Rev Doctor Martin Luther King Jr Boulevard. The Department of Safety and Inspections recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 30, 2017 and from 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 1, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off no later than 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 30, 2017 and no later than 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, October 1, 2017, the dates of the event.

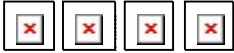
