This is to confirm that our office has received your applications for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that they are being processed. The above-referenced event will have amplified music/sound at the following locations: Mississippi River Boulevard and Marshall Avenue; Summit Avenue and Cretin-Cleveland Avenues; Summit Avenue and Prior Avenue North-Howell Street; Summit Avenue and Saratoga Street North-Fry Street North; Summit Avenue and Hamline Avenue-Syndicate Street; Summit Avenue and Lexington Avenue-Oxford Street; Summit Avenue and Dale Street- St. Albans Street; Summit Avenue and Selby Avenue-Virginia Street; and the State Capitol Complex. The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that variances be issued with conditions.

A public hearing on your request for variances has been scheduled for **Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
