Re: Order to remove or repair the structure at 672 Rivoli Street,

Dear Mr. Baltazar & Ms. Cothern:

The Saint Paul City Council adopted an Order to Remove or Repair the nuisance/dangerous building(s) at 672 Rivoli Street in Saint Paul within 180 days of March 1, 2017. The date the work is to be completed, per the Council resolution, is September 1, 2017. The measure of completion of the work and abatement of the nuisance/dangerous condition is the issuance of the Certificate of Code Compliance. To date, no certificate has been issued and the work remains incomplete. In order to make findings for Council consideration of the completeness of the work and need for city abatement of the nuisance/dangerous building(s), as well as the status of the performance deposit, a legislative hearing is being scheduled on **Tuesday September 12, 2017 at 10 a.m. in Room 330 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.** 

If your client has received the Certificate of Code Compliance by September 1, 2017, this hearing will be cancelled and a resolution will be forwarded to the City Council indicating the nuisance conditions have been abated and the matter is closed.

If your client has *not* received the Certificate of Code Compliance by September 1, 2017, they will need to work with Joe Yannarelly (joe.yannarelly@ci.stpaul.mn.us or 651-266-1920) to schedule an inspection to occur *prior to* the week of September 11, 2017. Both Mr. Yannarelly and a building inspector will conduct this inspection.

The findings of the Legislative Hearing will be considered at a City Council Public Hearing on Wednesday September 20, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers, Room 300 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.
