# **CORRECTION NOTICE**

#### Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **August 24, 2017** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code<sup>1</sup> (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. FINISH INSTALLING/REPLACING THE FENCE THAT WAS TAKEN DOWN.
- 2. INSTALL A SUPPORT/BRACE FOR THE REAR GATE AND PROP IT UP SO THAT IT IS NO LONGER LEANING.
- 3. REPLACE AND PAINT THE REAR GATE.
- 4. COMPLETELY FINISH REPLACING ALL BROKEN, DEFECTIVE, DILAPIDATED AREAS OF THE FENCING AND COMPLETELY FINISH PAINTING ALL PEELED, FLAKED, SCALED, CHALKING PAINT OR UNPAINTED WOOD SURFACES OF THE WHOLE FENCE.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after

### October 31, 2017 for items 1 and 2,

# June 1, 2018 for item 3 and 4,

by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges**<sup>2</sup> and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)

Any such future costs will be collected by assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.
