My name is Patrick A. Carlone, my son John P. Carlone, my daughters Clodet I. Carlone, Danette M. Carlone and my wife Clodetta A. Carlone are the owners of this property.

We are working with the Capitol Planning Department to acquire the proper zoning and building approval, at this point we have on file a land survey and some building permits that were taken out and some construction work has been completed by Xcel power company and Muska electrical company.

In the past the Saint Paul Parking Enforcement and the Saint Paul City Council voted to have our construction equipment removed that cost us over \$10,000 dollars.

For security reasons I am occupying this property until our new house is built.

In the event the City Council votes to remove our construction equipment and our personal property it should be noted our property is in the Capitol Approach Area and is governed by the State of Minnesota, only the State of Minnesota has jurisdiction.

Our property is gated and locked, If the our construction equipment and personal property is removed without a Federal Court order and signed by a Federal Judge we will call the Federal Bureau of Investigation to make arrest of all people involved.
