An inspection was made of your building on October 27, 2017 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on November 15, 2017 at 10:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Exterior Front SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited 1. to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Repair the deteriorating retaining wall in the front of the property in an approved manner.
- Exterior Front SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks 2. or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Repair the deteriorating front stairs.
- House Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free 3. from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Repair all holes in the soffit and discontinue the use of spay foam for these repairs,
- Throughout SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building. Allow 4. access to all areas of the building and property or enforcement action can be taken.
