Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on December 13, 2017. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on January 9, 2018 at 10:45 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Exterior Coffee Shop Location MSFC 506.1 When you have the correct keys available, call Fire Department Communication Center at (651) 266-7702 to make arrangements to have the keybox opened.12/06/17: follow up with fire department on the keys in keybox.
 Contact from SPFD regarding the keys in keybox not working. Call number above to meet SPFD and have copies of all keys for the building at time of meeting.
- 2. Interior Cafe MSFC 906.1, MN Stat. 299F.361 Provide approved fire extinguishers in accordance with the following types, sizes and locations.-12/06/17: observed a ABC class mounted under prep table behind trash can.
 Provide one K Class fire extinguisher within the cooking area of commercial kitchens. They must be permanently mounted between 3 and 5 feet high in readily visible and easily accessible locations.

3. Interior - Coffee Shop - MSFC 5303.5.3- Secure the pressurized cylinders to prevent falling caused by contact.12/06/17: Discontinue using the poly bungee straps and provide either chains or cylinder holder for the cylinders.
Check all.

4. Interior - From Unit 1 - SPLC 34.19 - Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-

Provide access to doors and area on roof.

5. Interior - Shoe shop back door - MSFC 1008.1.9.3 - Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-

Remove the bar and brackets from back door.

- 6. Interior Unit Bathrooms SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4714.01 (T) Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms.- Unit 1, 2, 3 have no natural or fan ventilation.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
