### **CORRECTION NOTICE**

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **December 20, 2017** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code<sup>1</sup> (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. The structure is a registered vacant building and must have a Code Compliance Certificate before the structure may be occupied. Immediately vacate the structure or obtain a Code Compliance Certificate from DSI You may contact Jim Seeger at DSI for code compliance inspection, permits, and issuance of Code Compliance Certificate. Under Chapter 33.03 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code, failure to obtain a Code Compliance Certificate or to vacate the structure may result in issuance of criminal summonses.
- 2. NO UNATTENDED VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED AT A REGISTERED VACANT BUILDING

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after **December 29, 2017**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges**<sup>2</sup> and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)


