Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 2nd Floor Hallway MSFC 1030.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit path. Remove objects from the hallway.
- 2. 2nd Floor Northwest Bedroom MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. The light fixture is hanging by the wires, secure the fixture.
- 3. Basement MMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Provide an approved dryer vent under permit by a licensed contractor.

- 4. Basement Throughout MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.
- 5. Interior MSFC 313.1 Fueled equipment, including but not limited to motorcycles, mopeds, lawn-care equipment and portable cooking equipment, shall not be stored, operator or repaired within a building. Remove the lawn mower from the front entry and the snow blower from the basement.
- 6. Main Level Kitchen MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials. Remove objects from on top of the stove.
- 7. Stairwell Basement MSFC 1030.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit path. Remove objects from the basement stairwell.
