Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 31, 2018 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on March 9, 2018 at 2:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door latch.-Repair latch on front storm door.
2. Interior - 2nd Floor - SPLC 34.13 (1) - Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over half the floor area. **Immediately stop using 2nd floor as a sleeping area. Only 80" ceilings at highest point.**
3. Interior - MSFC 605.6 - Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.

4. Interior - MSFC 605.4 - Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
5. Permit - MSBC -Section 105.1 - Permits Required. Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit.-**Have a licensed plumber pull a permit for water heater installed in 2016 with out one.**
6. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
