Overview of COPP

- Ward Allocation \$13,619 per Ward, total of \$95,333
- Average of 35 COPP contracts a year
- □ The estimated cost to administer the program is \$1,400 per contract (from 2017 analysis).
- Unspent funds
 - **2014 \$3,067**
 - **2015 \$6,231**
 - **2016 \$15,000**

Underspending Cause:

- The contract program was not executed.
- Contract was under budget.



Saint Paul District Councils

- Contracts with Community Engagement (PED) and COPP
- COPP Funding for District Council-
 - **2015 \$71,976**
 - **2016 \$69,553**
 - **2017 \$48,684**
- 2017 District Council Programs COPP funding supports-
 - 56% Community Study/Planning ex. District plan to be included in 10 year Comp Plan, Dales Street Commercial District, Pedestrian Safety
 - □ 32% Communication- ex. Newsletter/Newspaper
 - 12% Garden
