Description of Variance:

Location: Ontario Street and Shepard Road

Noise Source: Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance, at no specified sound level limit to provide the use of a sound system for announcements at Ontario Street and Shepard Road for the 2018 Get Lucky 7K. The variance is requested for the hours of 8:00 a.m.to 11:30 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m., on Saturday, March 17, 2018. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) the variance shall be for the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m., on Saturday, March 17, 2018 at Ontario Street and Shepard Road. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:30 a.m. on the date of the event.
