Dear Mr. Larson:

This is to confirm that our office has received your applications for variances from the city's noise ordinance and that they are being processed. The Team Ortho Foundation, 2018 Get Lucky 7K, will have amplified music/sound at the following three (3) locations along the race route, CHS Field, 360 N. Broadway Street, from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.; 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. at Sibley Street and Shepard Road; and Ontario Street and Shepard Road. The amplified sound will be used with a sound system, and a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m. for the 2018 Get Lucky 7K Run on Saturday, March 17, 2018. The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that variances be issued with conditions.

A public hearing on your request for variances has been scheduled for **Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
