Important Findings

- **Total Count of Persons**

- Not including doubled up, small increase of 6.8% from 2016 to 2017 (1,346 to 1,438 for HUD total)
- Including doubled up, significant increase of **45.8%** from 2016 to 2017 (to 1,963)

- **Doubled Up Count (new)**

- More doubled up (525) found than total count of persons in TH (488)

- **Unsheltered Count**

- Significant increase of **22%** from 2016 to 2017 (136 to 166) due to more participation, training, and identification

Important Findings (cont'd)

- **Transitional Housing**

- Total persons over age 24 significant increase of **24%** (169 to 209) due to increase in TH beds
 - Net decrease in youth TH beds (movement from TH to RRH)

- **Chronic Homeless**

- Total persons significant increase of **54%** from 2016 to 2017 (175 to 269)
 - Increase almost entirely within unsheltered count (+82 persons)

Important Findings (cont'd)

- **Sub Populations**

- Significant increases and decreases within all sub populations across sheltered (TH/ES) and unsheltered counts
 - HIV/AIDS increase due to new targeted TH projects (MN Aids Project)
 - Decreases possibly due to incomplete data, using HMIS, or definitional changes within individual agencies (severely mentally ill and chronic substance abuse)
 - Significant increases across almost all subpopulations from unsheltered count

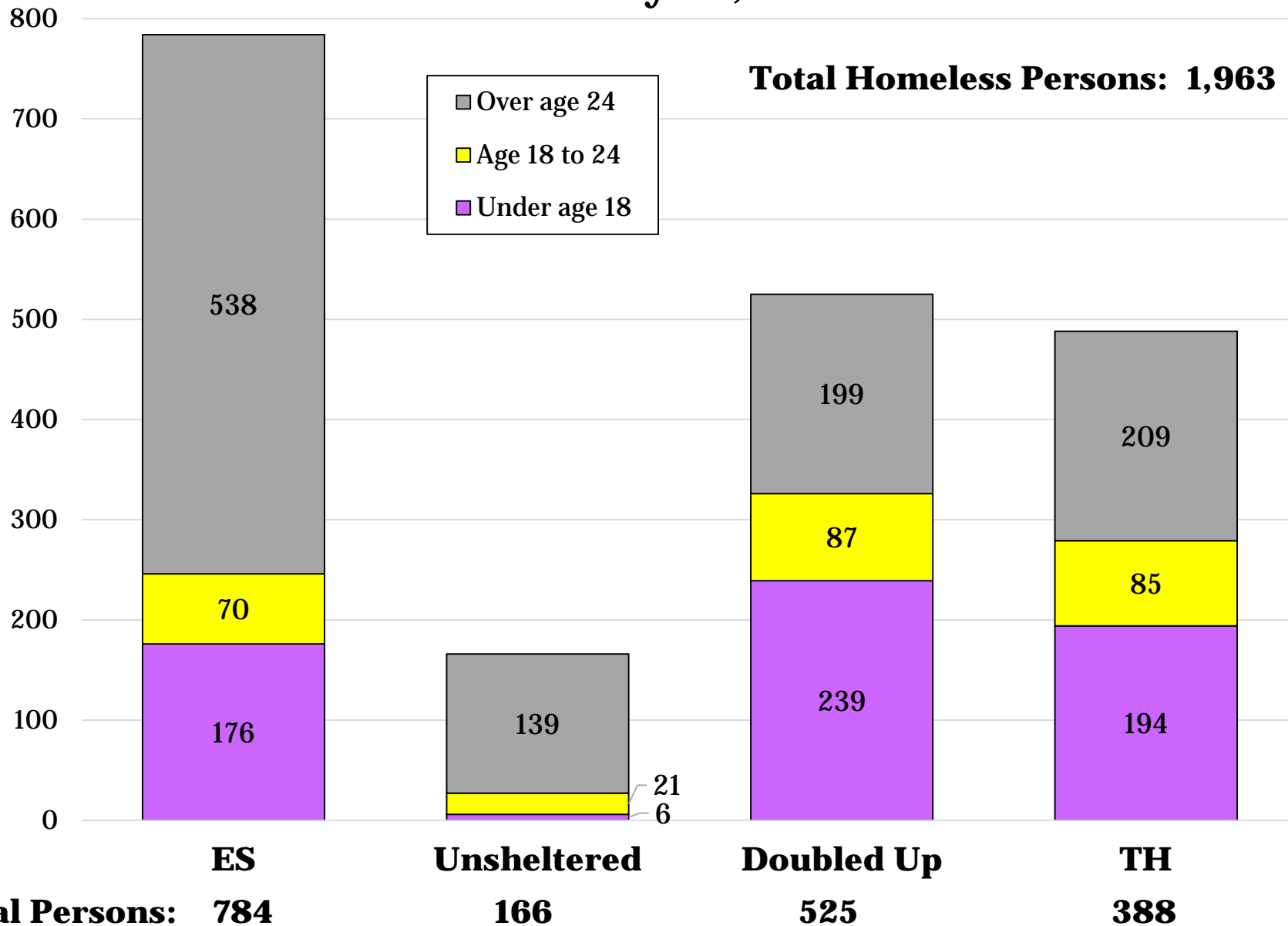

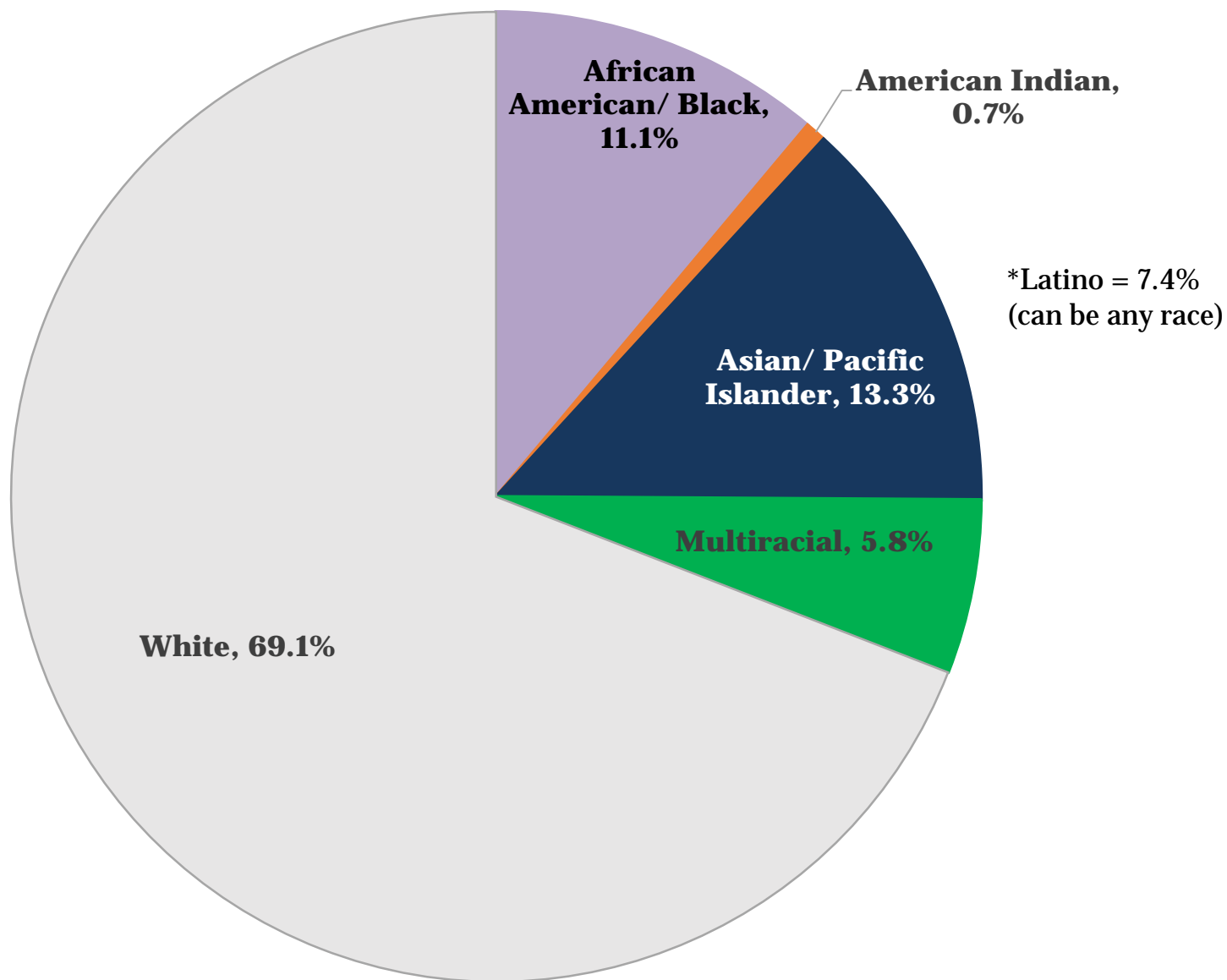

homeless population reported for the PIT**

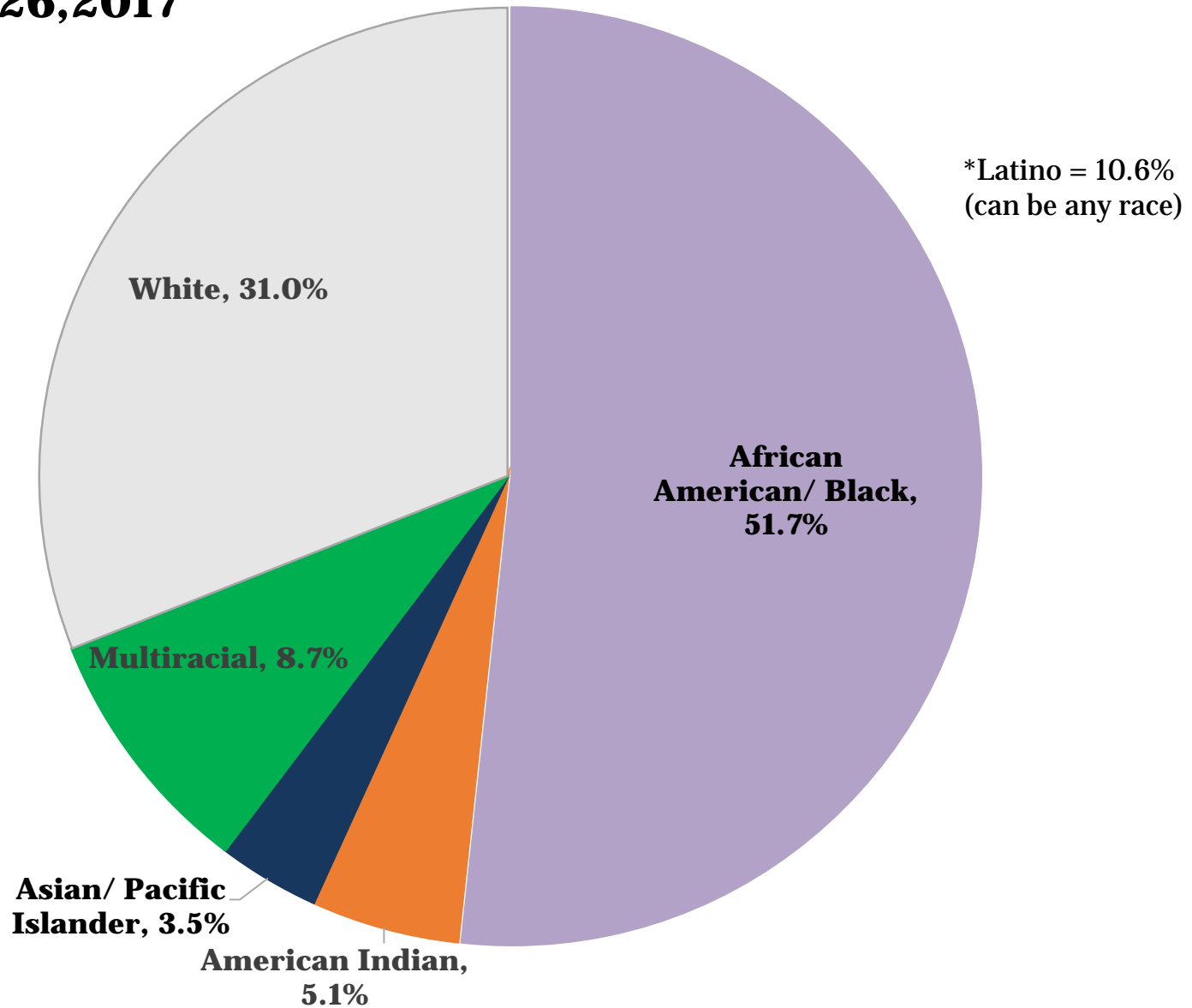

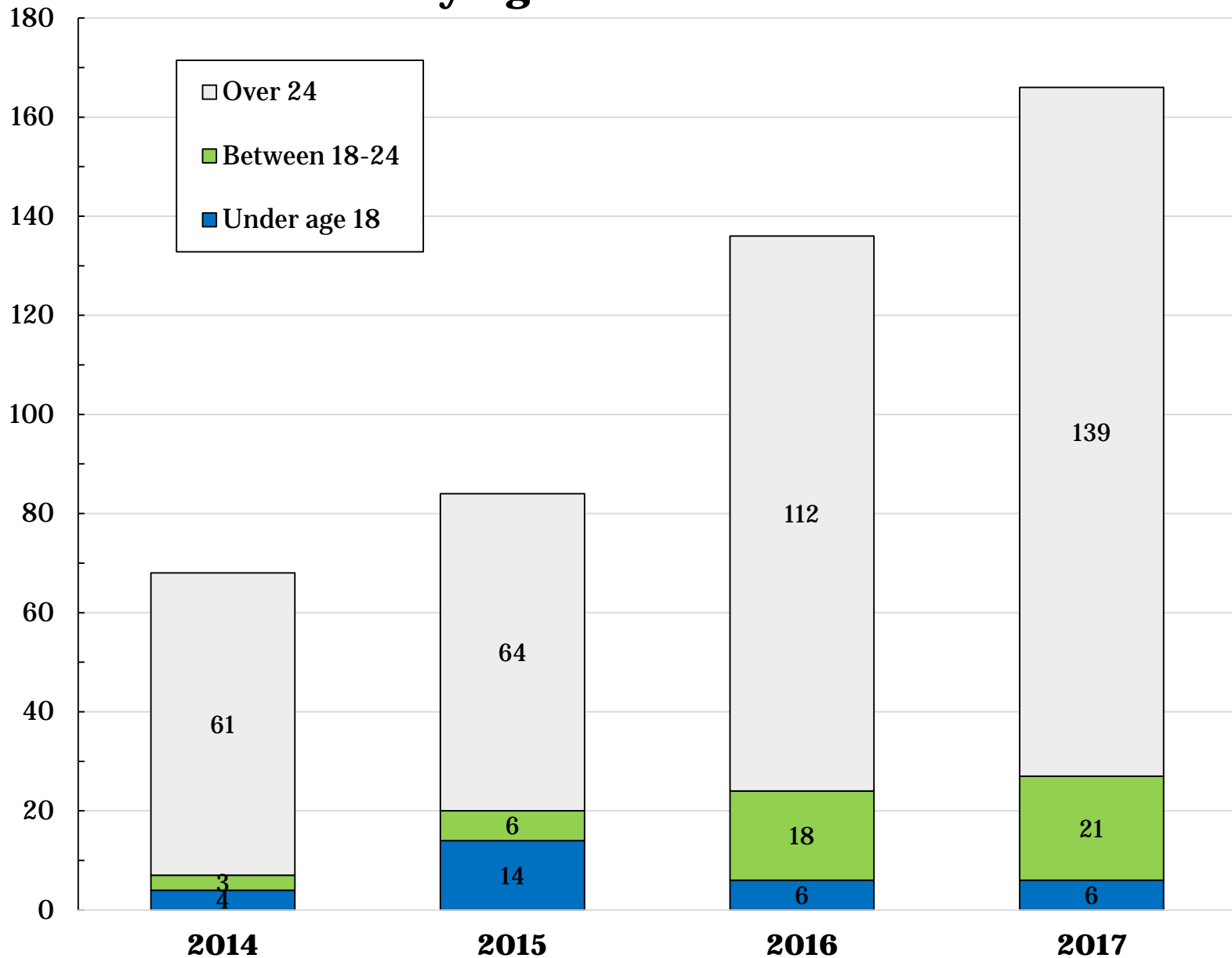

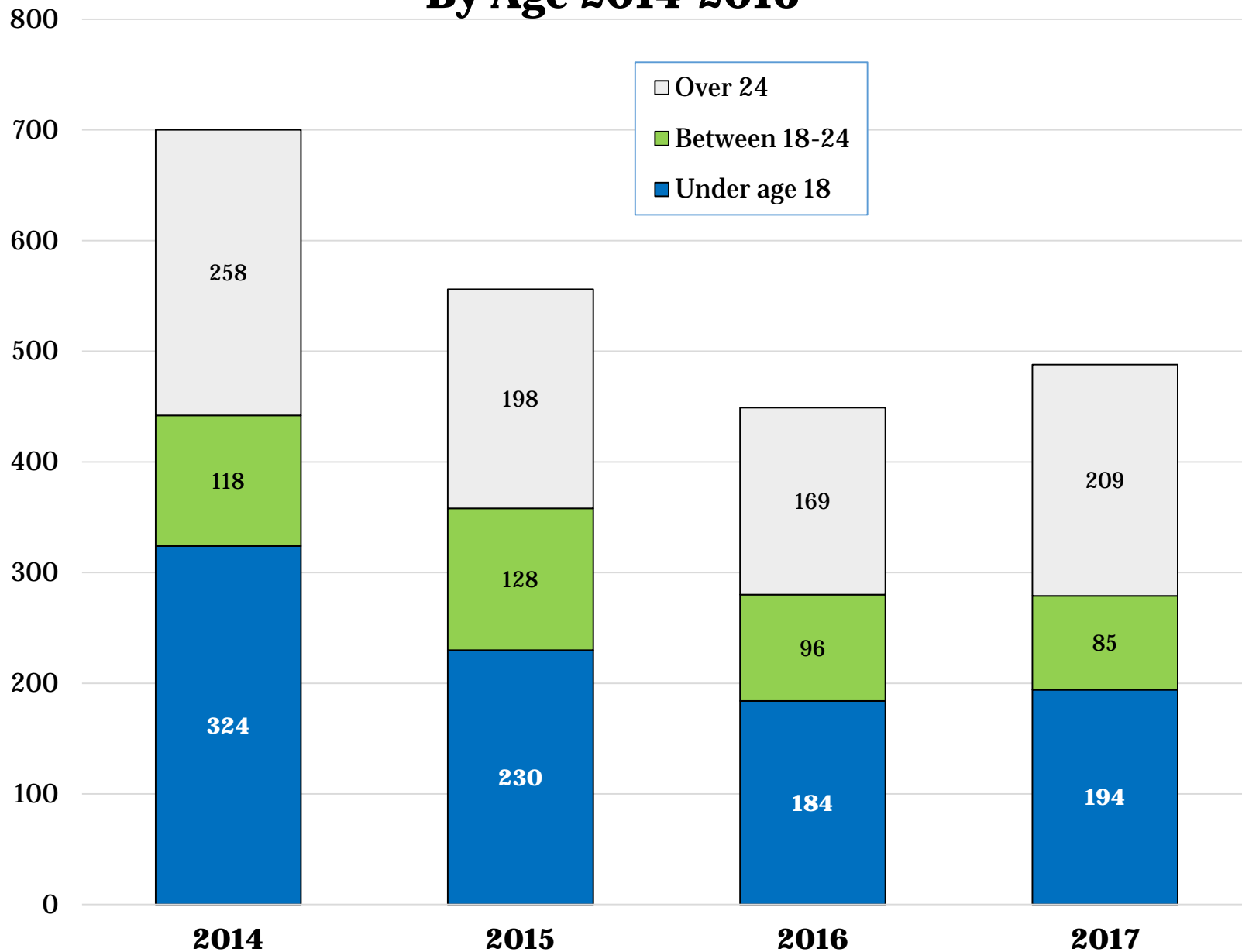
Persons in Point-in-Time Count, 2014-2017
