- 2. INTERIOR BASEMENT MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Missing cover plate on junction box.
- 3. INTERIOR BASEMENT NEC 408.7 Unused Openings for circuit breakers and switches shall be closed using identified closures, or other approved means that provide protection substantially equivalent to the wall enclosure.

- 4. INTERIOR KITCHEN SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.34 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.-Grease splatter on range, hood, ceiling, walls, floor and cabinets needs to be removed.
- /5. INTERIOR THROUGHOUT MSFC 605.4 Re-locatable power taps shall be of the polarized or grounded type, equipped with overcurrent protection, and shall be listed in accordance with UL 1363. Re-locatable power taps shall be directly connected to a permanently installed receptacle.-Power strips are plugged into adapters.
- 6. INTERIOR THROUGHOUT SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code.-KITCHEN: Tinfoil drip pans on the stove need to be removed. LIVING ROOM: Covers on the sides of the fireplace are missing.
