## NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 9, 2017.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

## CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

## DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Electrical - MSFC 605.1 - Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-

2. Interior - Throughout - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-Building has been condemned due to extensive fire damage.

3. Plumbing - SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 - Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition.-

4. Roof - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.33 (1) - Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.-

5. Siding - SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-

6. Throughout - SPLC 34.10 (2), 34.34(1) - Repair and maintain the damaged structural member. This repair may require a building permit, call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-

7. Windows - Throughout - SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) - Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-

8. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
