The sewer liner creates a new long-lasting pipe within the old sewer. The process of lining a sanitary sewer involves cleaning the sewer and then constructing a sewer liner.

Insituform, the Contractor, has applied for a sound level variance requesting to permission to perform the sewer cleaning and lining work on Selby between the centerline of Fairview and 1798 Selby during evening / nighttime hours. The process will occur over two separate nights. On the first night, the sewer will be cleaned. On the following night the sewer will be lined.
