NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance Lowertown Blues Festival – Mears Park

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Mears Park

Noise Source: Steve Heckler, Lowertown Blues Festival, has applied for a sound level variance, with a sound level request of 92 dBA at 100 feet, in order to provide music outdoors at Mears Park for Thursday, July 19 through Saturday, July 21, 2018, from noon to 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 2:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) the variance shall be for Thursday, July 19 through Saturday, July 21, 2018, with a pre-event sound check at 2:00 p.m. daily. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 85 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source from the hours of 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. pm July 19 and July 20, 2018, and shall not exceed 92 dBA at 50 feet from 5:01 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on July 19 and July 20, 2018 and from 12:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on July 21, 2018. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the performance dates of the event.
