went to the Trend Bar to obtain video.

Mark advised the new (trial) owners Katie and Jake Flemming told him they had some issues with their DVRs. They had 2 - the one downstairs had all the outside cameras that are shared with the building owner, and there is one upstairs that they did not know about.

The one upstairs was not functioning which is where the inside cameras record to. Mark stated he did some troubleshooting and called the manufacturer who told him to pull the hard drive to see if it would reboot. Mark stated it sounded like the DVR has not been recording for a while. Mark stated he advised the owners that the DVR was not functioning and to figure out something to get the inside cameras working as soon as possible.

The owners gave Mark their bouncer's number who told them that he had made a cell phone video before he started throwing people out of the bar.

This is a violation of condition # 11 which states:

Licensee will create a video surveillance camera and Lighting placement plan (Video Surveillance Plan) for the interior and exterior of the licensed premises. Licensee will submit the video Surveillance Plan to the Saint Paul Police Department liaison with The Department of Safety and Inspection for review and approval. In accordance with the approved Video Surveillance Plan, licensee will ensure that video surveillance cameras are installed by December 31, 2016. Licensee will maintain installed video surveillance cameras in working order; ensure that they are recording 24-hours per day and capable of producing surveillance video in a commonly used, up-to-date format. Licensee will retain surveillance video for a minimum of thirty (30) days. If an incident is deemed serious by SPPD, Licensee shall make surveillance video immediately available for viewing by SPPD. If a copy of a surveillance video for a serious incident is requested by SPPD, Licensee shall have the technology, materials and staff available to immediately make the copy. In all other cases, Licensee shall provide a copy of the surveillance video to the requestor within 48 hours.
