Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on June 4, 2018, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A re-inspection will be made on July 5, 2018 at 9:30 AM or the property vacated. The property is being revoked due to long term non-compliance and non-compliance with the Legislative Hearing Officer's determination to have the work completed on June 1, 2018.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior - Alley Side - SPLC 34.08 (7) - All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt. concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090. Maintain Park in the rear of the building.
- 2. Exterior - Building - SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Paint peeling throughout the fascia/soffits, window frames.

- 3. Exterior Property SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, retaining walls, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Retaining wall.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
