<p>During many high risk situations when Medics are needed they are required to stage a short distance away until the scene is secure. It's during these crucial minutes that sometimes mean the difference between life and death. At some point, we may need to act to save the life of our fellow officer or citizen. It is imperative that we have officers trained and equipped to handle life threatening injuries (knife/stab wounds, gunshots, or other serious bleeding injuries including arterial bleeding) when Medics are delayed.</p> <p>SPPD is requesting grant funds through the 100 Club Fund to purchase 400 Individual Patrol Medic Kits along with the required training to deploy them.</p>					
Please describe the specifics of the project, how it will be carried out, and goals to address the situation above:					
<p>SPPD is requesting funding for individual Patrol Medic Kits.</p> <p>The Medic kit was created with the help of SPFD Captain Ken Adams (EMS Coordinator). Each kit comes in a MOLLE bag (can be affixed to plate carrier vest) and is designed for rapid access to control bleeding and control airway management.</p> <p>Each KIT contains the following items: 1-Tactical Operators Response Bag – black, 1-CPR Microshield, 1-4 InNAR trauma dressing, 1-Hyfin Chest Seal twin pack, 1-Combat Tourniquet, 1-Trauma shears – black, 1-Nasal airway 28 fr, 2-Glove packs (2 gloves per pack) 1-Surgical tape roll – 2 inch, 2-ABD dressing 8 x 10, and 1-S rolled gauze 4.5 x 4.1 yard.</p> <p>Every Patrol Officer will be trained by SPFD during in-service training or roll call prior to deploying with the Kit. Once trained and equipped Officers will be able to potentially save a fellow Officer's life or citizen's when Medics are delayed.</p>




Please describe the situation, issue or need for this project:

SPPD is requesting grant funds to purchase equipment to advance officer safety and training through the 100 Club Fund. This includes protective gear, training mats, ballistic gear and less lethal launchers (example rubber bullets). At a base level the equipment provides additional protection and officer safety during dangerous situations.

Equipment used during officer training will advance critical thinking and scenario based training. High quality training requires that officers remain in a composed state of mind, and therefore situational based training must maintain an element of surprise. This ensures officers are not trained to be 'hyper vigilant' and overly sensitive to any perceived threat of violence. At times, officers are given clues that their next training scenario will include a life threatening situation just by being the only officer to receive safety equipment. The additional equipment will allow SPPD to equip every officer involved in the scenario, the trainee, trainer, and the role players. As its stands now, training is limited by the lack of equipment. It does not provide for the full spectrum of scenarios that officers would encounter in a real life scenario. This ensures that training techniques emphasize deescalation as a possible response for officers during incidents.

Please describe the specifics of the project, how it will be carried out, and goals to address the situation above:

SPPD is requesting funding for equipment that will support ongoing operations and the activities of our Professional Development Institute. The request support two of the 6 defined pillars of 21st Century Policing being advanced by the department.

- Training and Education: SPPD has a robust training program focused on officer safety, service with respect, and best practices around deescalation, crisis intervention, implicit bias and developing leadership skills.
- Officer Wellness and Safety: SPPD understands that officers who have exceptional training, skills, knowledge, and support are better prepared to keep our community and each other safe.
