Requested Board Action

Approval of an agreement for Kennedy & Graven, Chartered to provide legal services to the

HRA as necessary and appropriate for the redevelopment of the Ford Site.

Background

The City is beginning the process for redevelopment of the Ford Site which is made up of a 122-

acre parcel main redevelopment site, and may include the 13-acre Canadian Pacific Railway

parcel to the south and a river parcel across Mississippi River Boulevard also owned by Ford.

The HRA is in need of a law firm to provide expert development legal services related to the

redevelopment of the Ford Site.

Kennedy & Graven, Chartered currently provides bond counsel and related public finance legal

services for the HRA in its development and redevelopment activities in consultation with the

HRA Attorney under a Master Legal Services Agreement.

The HRA and the City Attorney Office (CAO) conducted a search of law firms to provide legal

services akin to those currently covered under the existing agreement to the City and the HRA

related to the Ford Site redevelopment. CAO has determined Kennedy & Graven, Chartered as

fully qualified and is seeking approval of a Ford Site master legal services agreement with

Kennedy & Graven, Chartered for a period of three years commencing August 9, 2018, and

continuing until August 31, 2021 (the "Agreement").

In addition to general legal services to be performed under the Agreement for the Ford Site

redevelopment project, the Agreement authorizes services for specific projects within the Ford

Site with terms of such engagements to be agreed to and contracted for by the execution of an exhibit to the Agreement.

The form of the proposed Agreement with Kennedy & Graven is attached.

The City Council has also been requested to take action with respect to approving a Ford Site legal services agreement with Kennedy & Graven, Chartered.
