 - -The wood on the wheelchair ramp is deteriorated in multiple areas, including handrails and guardrails. Immediately repair or replace the wheelchair ramp. All work must be done by a qualified contractor and under permit.

07/19/2018: The wood on the wheelchair ramp is still deteriorated in multiple areas. Ramp also has unprotected wooden surfaces (scrape/paint) where needed. Immediately repair or replace the wheelchair ramp. All work must be done by a qualified contractor and under permit.
