Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. #2 Electric shut off SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.
- 2. #2 North side SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-There was a broken window on the second floor north side of the building.




