The above-referenced event will have amplified music/sound at the following locations: Cathedral Hill Park; 2nd Street between Kellogg Mall Park and Jackson; Shepard Road between Homer Street and Elway Street; Shepard Road between Washington Street and Eagle Street; and Upper Landing Park. The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that variances be issued with conditions.

A public hearing on your request for variances has been scheduled for **Wednesday, October 3, 2018 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.
