Dear City Council members,

We are requesting an appeal regarding the Vacant Building registration renewal to we've struggled to get the rebuild process moved forward. Here is a brief timeline events.

On November 8, 2017 our house caught fire.

November 9, 2017 we hired public adjuster Jim Whalen of Whalen and Associates.

Whalen instructed us not to remove any contents until inventory was finalized with a insurance. Whalen's estimated conclusion of claim was December, 2017.

November 2017 through March 2018, while waiting on claim submission, reached contractors who advised us to call them when they could access the house.

March 2018, Whalen said we could remove content from only the first floor.

We reached out to our prior contacts that we were ready to start, but they were now unavailable. We sought out new contractors and were advised to have blueprints as to received bids.

April through September 2018, tried to get blueprints drawn, bringing our 118 year — home up to code.

September 20, 2018, received approved blueprints

September 21, 2018 submitted blueprints to DSI. Instructed to provide report of inspector sewer lines before permits would be issued. Hired sewer inspector.

Deptember 28, 2018 received and provided DSI with sewer inspection report. City required property surveyed before permits would be issued.

September 28, 2018 received letter from city dated September 19, issuing fine and equesting it paid by September 26, 2018.

October 1, 2018 went to court house to request appeal. Told we were to late and had pay it.

October 18, 2018 call city council president Amy Brendmoen's office requesting help getting permits pulled. Email sent to Ward 1.

October 23, 2018 received email from Dai Thao's office stating they will contact D&

betaber 24, 2018 received surveyor report, submitted it to DSi.

October 29, 2018 still waiting for our contractor to receive permits so we can rebuilt

We feel we've worked as diligently as we could to keep the process moving along would like nothing better than to be back in our home.

VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION RENEWAL NOTICE

Dear Sir or Madam:

As the owner or responsible person for the property located at 362 TOPPING ST

you are required by law to register this building with the Department of Safety and Inspections on the form provided with this letter and to pay the annual Vacant Building registration fee of \$2,127.00 . The purpose of this fee is to provide partial reimbursement to the City for administrative costs. This fee is due annually as required in Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The renewal due date for this building is **November 13, 2018**. The annual registration fee and the enclosed registration form for this building is due on the renewal date. If you pay by mail, please fill in the enclosed registration form and return it with your payment.

If the registration fee is not received in this office within 45 days of the date of this letter, the full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

You may pay this registration fee online by going to **online.stpaul.gov** and selecting the 'Make a Payment' option. You will need your customer number and bill number to process a payment both can found on this letter.

You may file an appeal to this fee or registration requirements by contacting the City Clerk's Office by calling (651)266-8688. Any appeal of this fee must be made within ten (10) days of the date of this notice.

The Code Enforcement Officer has notified the Building Inspection and Design Section that this property meets the legal definition of a registered vacant building and in accordance with Legislative Code Chapter 33, no permits (except demolition, wrecking and removal permits) will be issued until the requirements of all applicable ordinances are fulfilled.

All catergory 2 and category 3 vacant buildings must be winterized with gas and water services shut off or, alternately, an excess flow gas valve must be installed in the dwelling, within sixty (60) days of the date of this notice.

WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL IS REQUIRED BEFORE A CATEGORY 2 OR CATEGORY 3 VACANT BUILDING CAN BE OCCUPIED OR SOLD.

- **Category 2**: Requirements include: 1. register/re- register the building, 2. pay outstanding fee(s), 3. obtain a code compliance report, 4. submit for approval a rehab cost estimate from a licensed contractor and a schedule for completion of all code compliance work, 5. submit proof of financial responsibility acceptable to the City, and 6. obtain Zoning approval of the proposed use.
- **Category 3:** All requirements listed for Category 2 vacant buildings, AND obtain a **Certificate of Occupancy** OR **Certificate of Code Compliance** prior to the sale of the building.

If the use of this building meets the definition of a nonconforming use by the Zoning Code, then the use will lose its nonconforming status 365 days from the date the building was declared vacant.

You must contact the Enforcement officer, Matt Dornfeld, at 651-266-1902 to find out what must be done before this building can be legally reoccupied.

The Enforcement Officer may declare this building to constitute a Nuisance Building subject to demolition and issue an Order to Abate under authority of Legislative Code Chapter 45. In the event this building is declared a Nuisance Building, subject to demolition, the Enforcement Office will notify all owners and interested parties of the Order to Abate as provided in the Legislative Code Chapter 45.
