- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 4. SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-

- 5. MSFC 807.2 Provide documentation that decorative materials have been treated and maintained with an approved flame retardant or remove decorative materials that do not meet the flame retardant requirements.- Remove all sheets from all door ways
- 6. MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located outside each sleeping area.-
