There will be a Legislative Hearing on November 20 at 11:00 a.m. in Room 330 City Hall to determine if the nuisance condition has been abated. In my letter, I mentioned a public hearing of November 21 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 300. This has been changed to November 28 due to no public hearing on November 21<sup>st</sup>.

If you wish to attend both hearings, you may do so. I have copied the inspector in this matter. If you are not in compliance, the Council will authorize the inspector to proceed with enforcement of the abatement after the November 28 Council hearing.
