NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE BECAUSE NOT WATER SERVICE AND NO GAS SERVICE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 8, 2018.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

- 4. SPLC 34.11(5), 34.35(2), MPC 408.3 Provide adequate hot water between 120 degrees F and 130 degrees F.-
 - 5. SPLC 34.11 (6) Provide and maintain a minimum of 68 degrees F in all habitable rooms at all times.-
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
