CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **October 01**, **2018** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- The exterior walls and/or trim of the garage has defective, peeled, flaked, scaled or chalking paint or has unpainted wood surfaces. Scrape and repaint to effect a sound condition in a professional manner. PLEASE SCRAPE AND PAINT THE GARAGE.
- The roof is deteriorated, defective, or in a state of disrepair. Repair or replace the roof covering to a sound, tight and water impervious condition. Permit may be required.
 FOUND GARAGE ROOF IN DISREPAIR. PLEASE RELACE THE DETERIORATED GARAGE ROOF UNDER PERMIT.
- 3. GARAGES AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES. All garages and accessory structures must be in sound condition and secure from unauthorized entry. Repair or replace any missing doors, windows, or hardware for same. FOUND GUTTER FALLING OFF THE ALLEY SIDE OF THE GARAGE. PLEASE REPAIR, REPLACE OR REMOVE THE FALLEN GUTTER.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on **November 01, 2018**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.
