Your building was inspected on July 10, 2018, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on December 3, 2018 at 11:00 A.M. or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. A Bedroom SE Corner MSFC 1029.1 Emergency escape and rescue openings are not required from basements or sleeping rooms that have and exit door or exit access door that opens directly into a public way or to a yard court . Bedroom window opens into a lock ed enclosed porch.-
- 2. A MSFC 1008.1.9.3 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort. Rear exit door.-
- 3. B Freezer NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as: room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-

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- 4. B MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-
- 5. B SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989-
