If items are not completed by December 30, 2018, the property must be vacated. The certificate of occupancy is being revoked for long term non-compliance. A re-inspection will be made on or after December 31, 2018.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

- 2. Exterior Building SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Paint peeling throughout the fascia/soffits, window frames.
- 3. Exterior Property SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, retaining walls, sheds and fences shall be maintained

structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Retaining wall.

4. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
