Legislative Hearings were conducted on July 17, 2018, July 31, 2018 and August 14, 2018 before Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer, and she recommended that the City Council grant 180 days for the nuisance building to be abated by razing and removal or rehabilitation, as evidenced by issuance of a Certificate of Code Compliance.

Making Finding the Order to raze and remove the structure at 1332 Dayton Avenue

There will be a Legislative Hearing scheduled for **Tuesday**, **February 26**, **2019** at **10:00** a.m. in **Room 330** City Hall at which DSI staff will present information on the current building conditions and progress toward abatement of the nuisance conditions.

If you have received your Certificate of Code Compliance by February 26, 2019, this hearing will be cancelled and a resolution will be forwarded to the City Council indicating the nuisance conditions have been abated and the matter is closed.

If you have *not* received your Certificate of Code Compliance by February 26, 2019, you will need to contact Joe Yannarelly (joe.yannarelly@ci.stpaul.mn.us or 651-266-1920) to schedule an inspection to occur *prior to* the week of February 26, 2019. Both Mr. Yannarelly and a building inspector will conduct this inspection.

The findings of the Legislative Hearing will be considered at a City Council Public Hearing on Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at 3:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers, Room 300 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.
