Noise Source: Jim Vanek, Events Manager, has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 95 decibels (dBA) at no specified distance, to present amplified music in an enclosed tent with use of a sound system for St. Patrick's Day Events on Friday, March 15, Saturday, March 16 and Sunday, March 17, 2019 at 150 Smith Ave. N. The variance is requested for the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Friday, March 15, 2019, 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Saturday, March 16, and from 12:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, March 17, 2019 with a prevent sound check one (1) hour prior to event start. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Friday, March 15, 2019, 12:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Saturday, March 16, and from 12:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. on Sunday, March 17, 2019 with a pre-event sound check one (1) hour prior to event start for the St. Patrick's Day Events. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources outside of the fully enclosed tent from 4:00 p.m. until 7:59 p.m. on March 15, 12:00 p.m. until 9:59 p.m. on March 16 and from 12:00 p.m. until 4:29 p.m. on March 17, 2019. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 7:59 p.m. on March 15, no later than 9:59 p.m. on March 16 and no later than 4:29 p.m. on March 17, 2019.
